The urge to do work which is unique to me – that led me to consider starting my own business.

When I was working as a freelance writer for many years, I always felt that I could be replaced at any time. "I need to do work that's more unique to me, but does that mean I have to create jobs on my own?"—such a sense of urgency made me think about starting my own business.

I got a tip for starting a business from what I had been thinking about vaguely as a career consultant. Many people who work as a qualified counselor continue to study hard to improve their own skills to live up to the official qualification as an expert. However, opportunities for self-improvement such as training sessions are offered only in big cities like Tokyo, so counselors living in rural areas often have difficulty participating in those events. That's how I started wondering if there was any way for them to improve their skills easily while living in rural areas.

The Tokyo One-Stop Business Establishment Center pushed my back hard.

Then I hit upon an idea to plan and produce educational videos for counselors to improve their skills and abilities. Of course, major training/development firms are already conducting a similar business, but I am the very person who constantly wonders what she needs to do to grow as a career consultant. Moreover, I have long experience working as a writer/editor, and I thought by leveraging such unique experience I could create something different than the big companies offer.

On the other hand, I knew there was little hope for me to gain enough social credibility if I remained working as a sole proprietor. So I decided to establish a company and started to search online for information about what I had to do for that. I was surprised to find out that I could set up a company myself without having an expert perform the procedures for me.
