If there is no "place to learn" with their children, let's make one!

When I was single, and even after I got married, I spent my time freely to learn about what I was interested in. However, after I had a baby, the life has completely changed. My child became a new center of my life.

That was good thing for me to feel parent's responsibility and spend time with my child. However, I stated to feel a bit of stress because things didn't go smooth by spending time with my child and continuing to work at the same time with a few collaborators. Not only spending my time to work, I also wanted to learn something new. (In my case, English school was an important place to learn) But I faced the reality that I can't take my children to the English lesson, and I can't find a baby sitter either. During such time, I strongly felt "There is something going wrong!"

I repeatedly wondered what I can do to change this situation, but I couldn't come up with a good idea. In the middle of the hard time, I finally came up with this idea, "Let's make it myself!" This is how I decided to start my business.

I was not thinking about establishing a company from the beginning, TOSBEC gave me the confidence.

However, I was not thinking of setting up a company from the beginning. I wanted to make something which will last for long time. To do that, it is necessary to make it a business. If so, it makes sense if I started a company. In the beginning, I had no idea about the procedure to set up a company. I was thinking that "It would surely be bothersome to start a company," and the thought stopped me to move forward.
